

Some topics for consideration for the Swimming summit.

Governance and management;

- Update discussion regarding what structure has been put in place to replace the Swimming STC
- What is the business plan with time lines for the development of an Independent Federation. At the 2007 IPC GA the membership mandated that all IPC sports should have achieved IF status by 2016.

IPC Swimming rules and regulations;

- Update on revision including the incorporation of motions passed at the 2006 Swimming Forum.
- Alignment with FINA, swim wear, equipment (starting blocks, utilisation of underwater video for rule infringements etc. Maximum age of officials.

Classification;

- Update on revision of classification manual.
 - Any- proposed changes to the current classification system.
 - Update regarding the classification of S14 athletes.
 - Allocation of classification status and protest opportunities
 - Who reviews protests submitted as we don't have a Head of Classification

Identification of events for future Paralympic Games;

- Number of events to be offered at the London 2012 Paralympic Games
How will the London 2012 Paralympic Games events be identified.
- Time lines for identification of London 2012 Paralympic Games events
- Impact of possible S14 inclusion

SDMS;

- Update with demonstration of full system
- Can all licensed athletes from all nations be viewed by all NPC's
- Are all rankings and records automatically updated and published or is there a delay due to manual uploading to web site.
- Can the system generate an e-mail to all NPC's indicating every time rankings and records are updated.
- Introduction of IPC Swimming disability points linked to ranking performances

- Establishment of an international disability points system;
 - Contact Germany to see if they would consider submitting their system for adoption.
